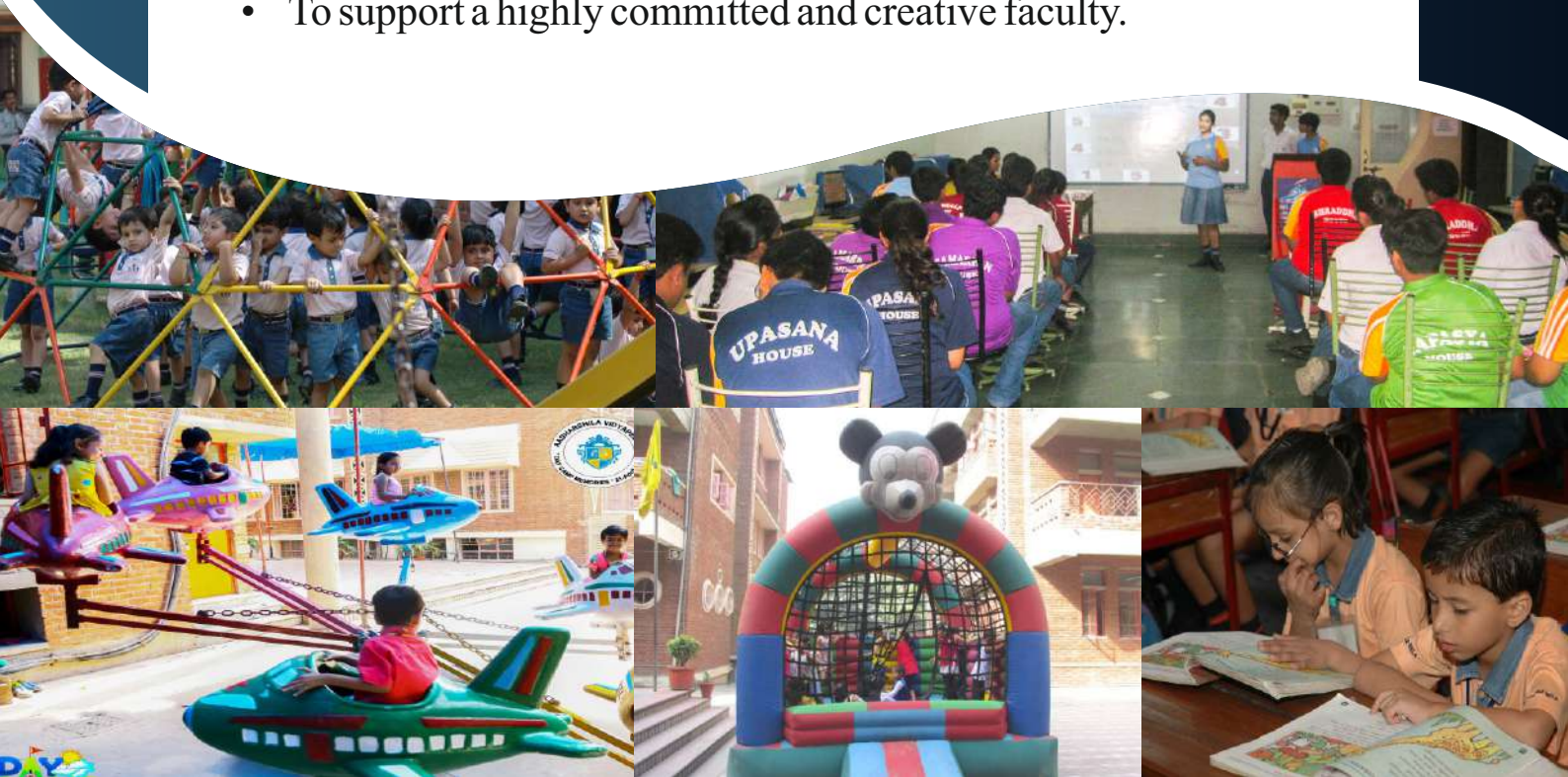
VISION

- To support a highly committed and creative faculty.

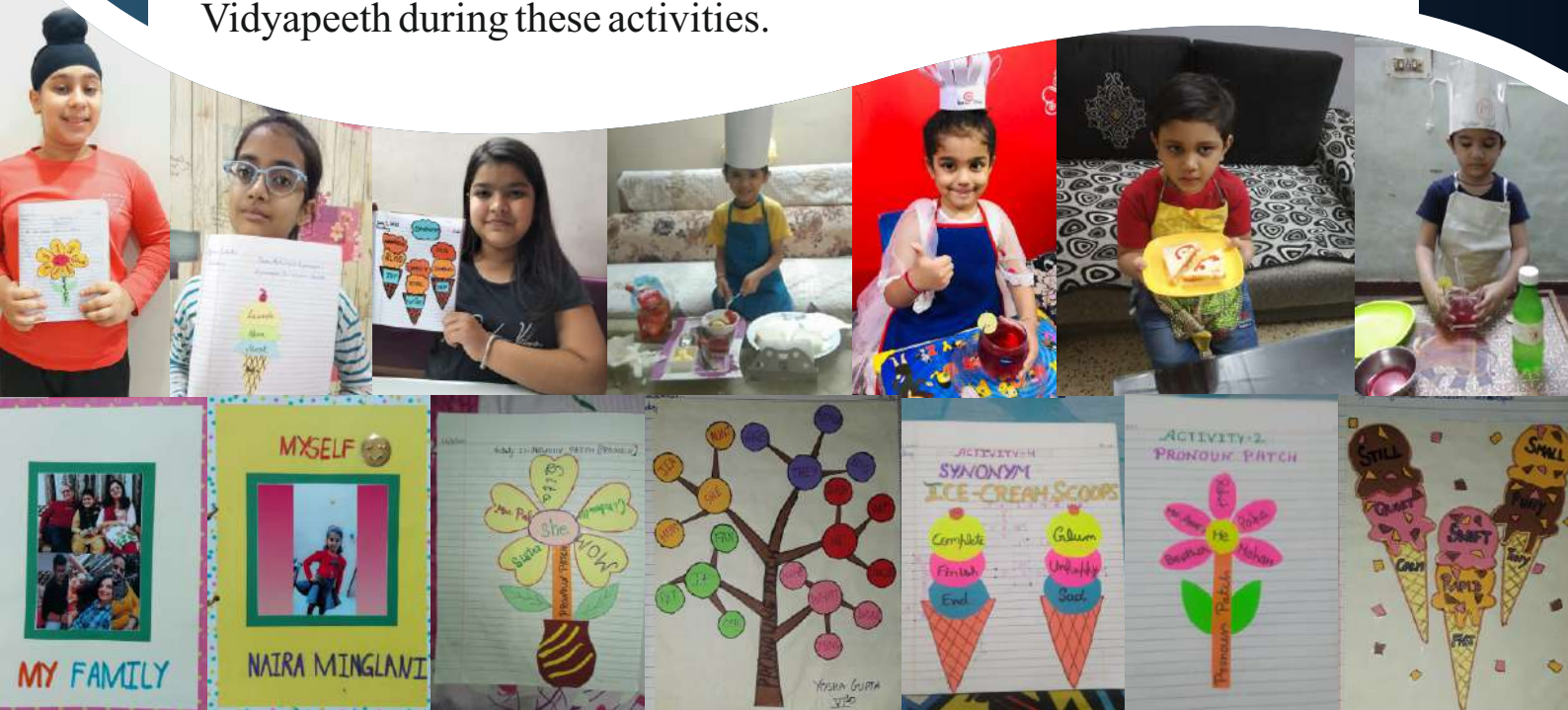




FUN LEARNING IN NEW SESSION

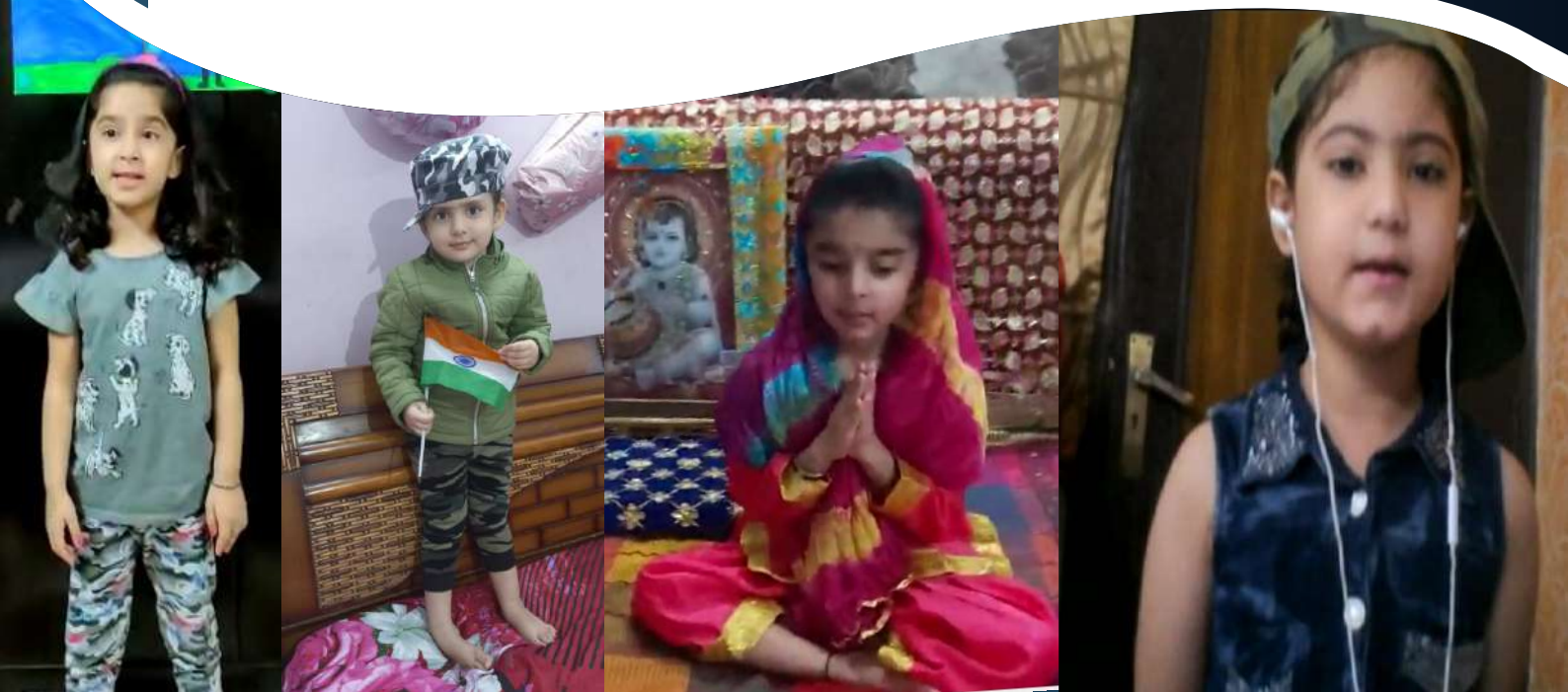


COMPETITION AT ITS BEST

FIT INDIA MOVEMENT

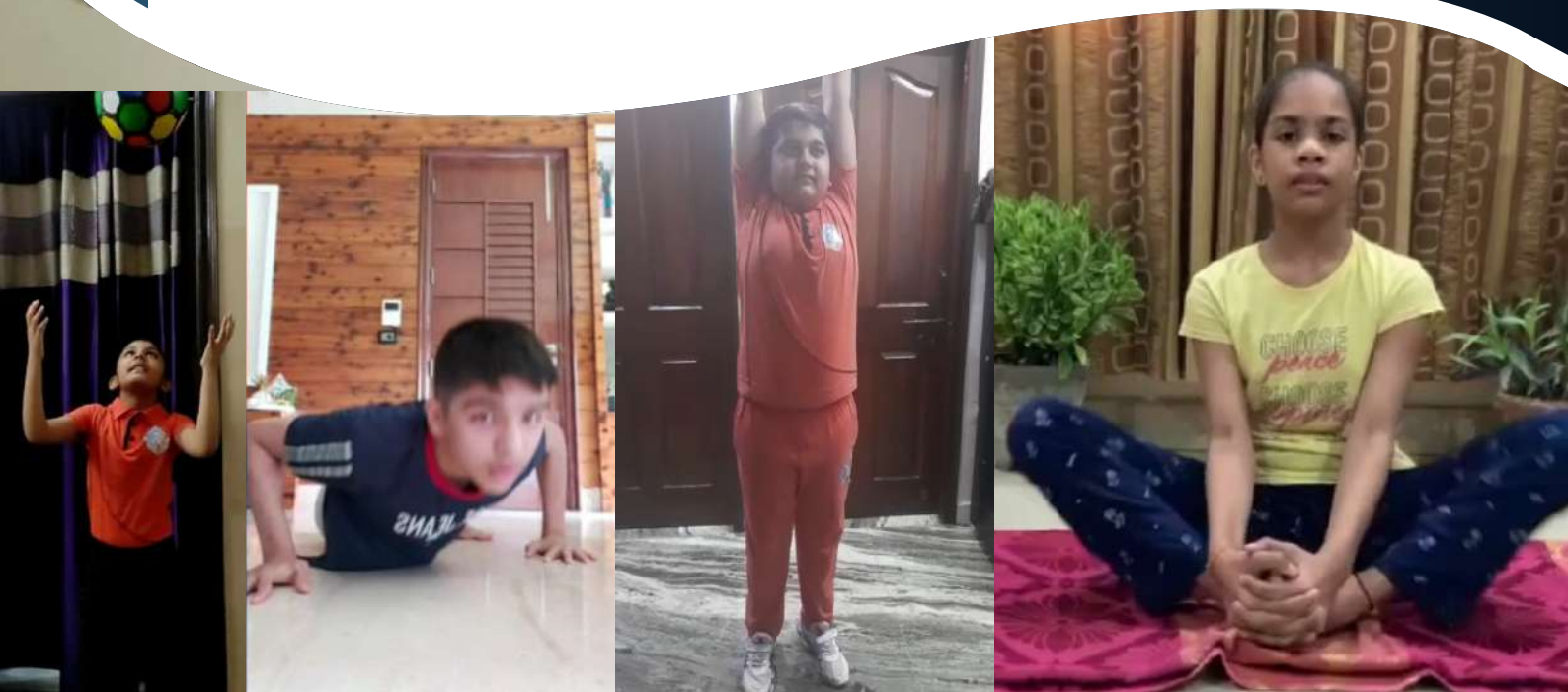
“Physical fitness is the first requisite of happiness.”

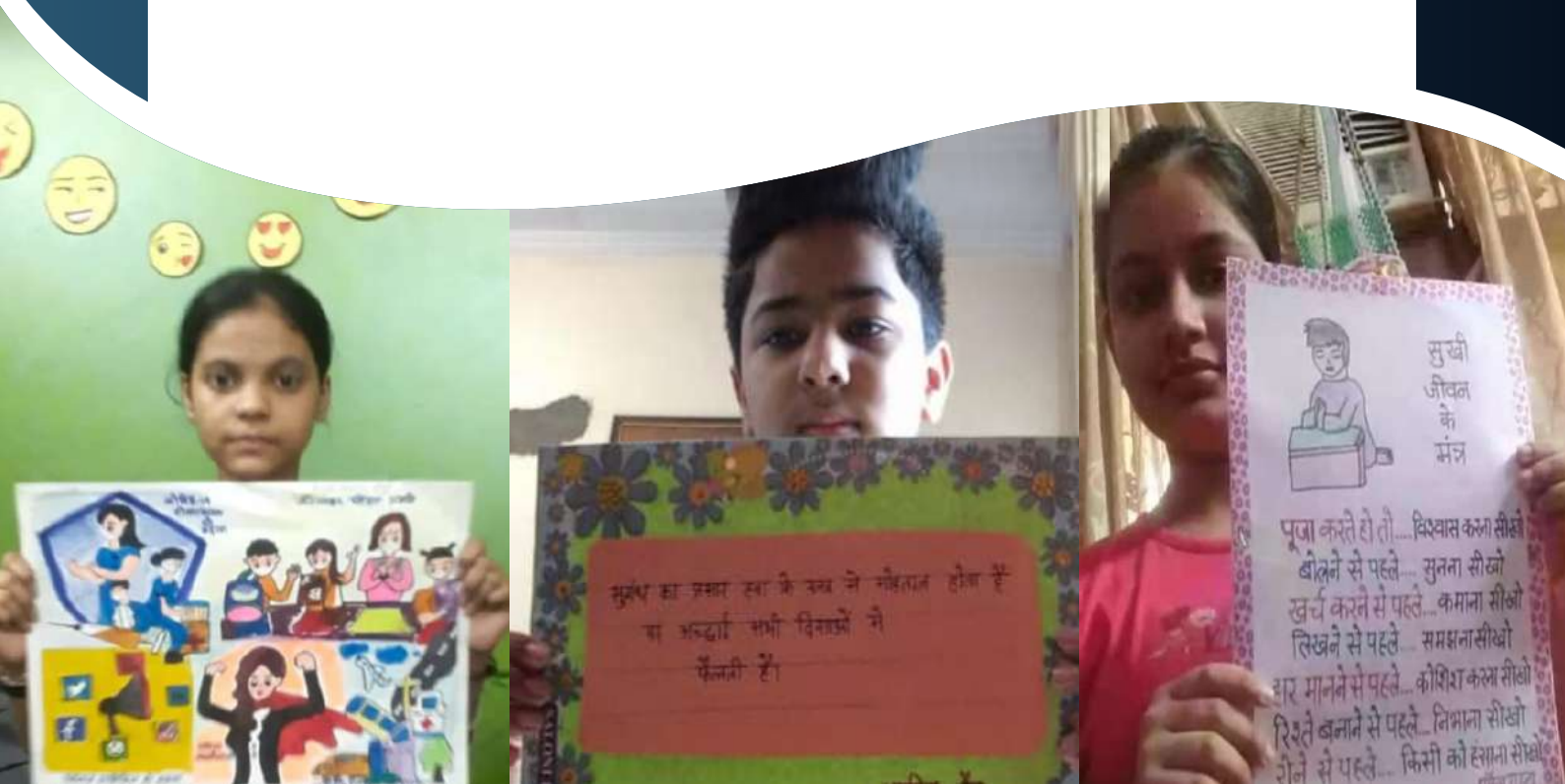
हिंदी सप्ताह

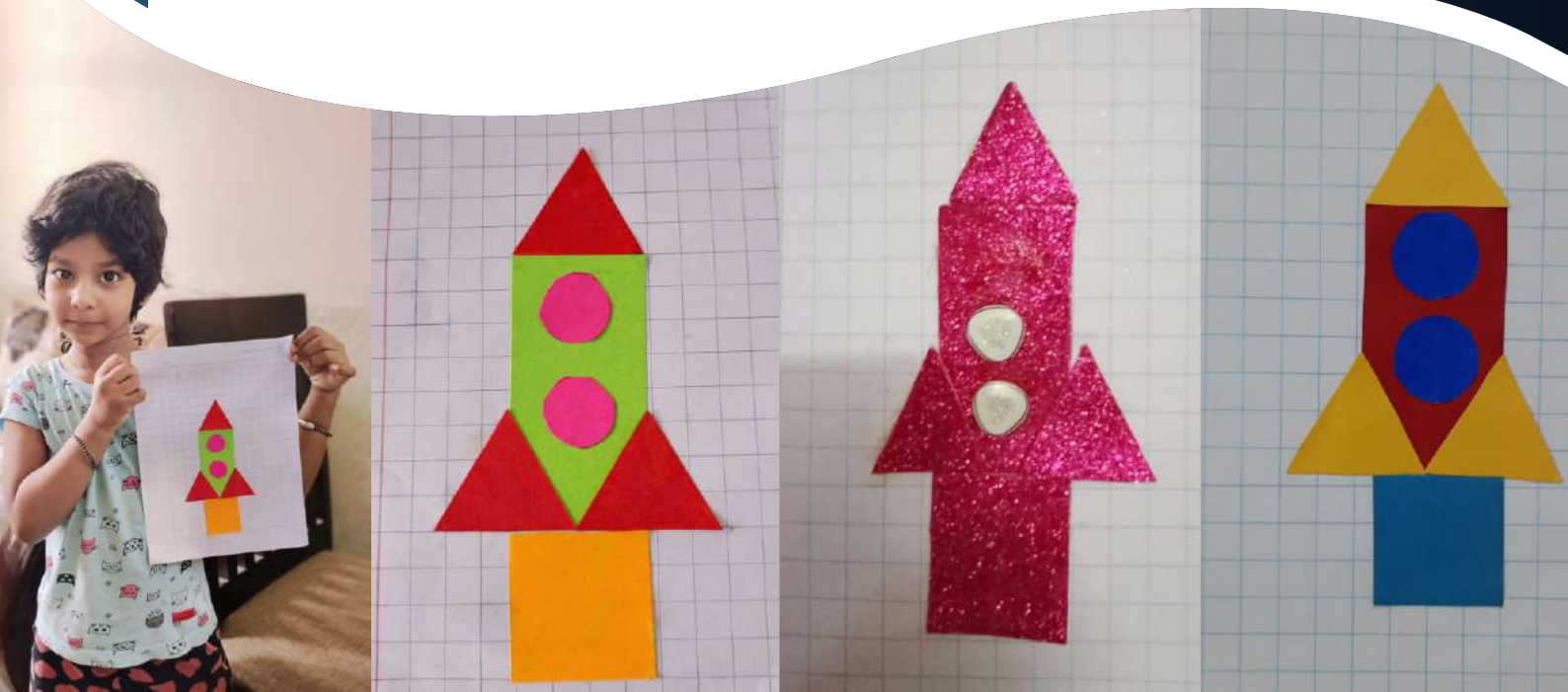




FUN WITH SHAPES ACTIVITY
