Aadharshila Vidyapeeth observes Cyber Week

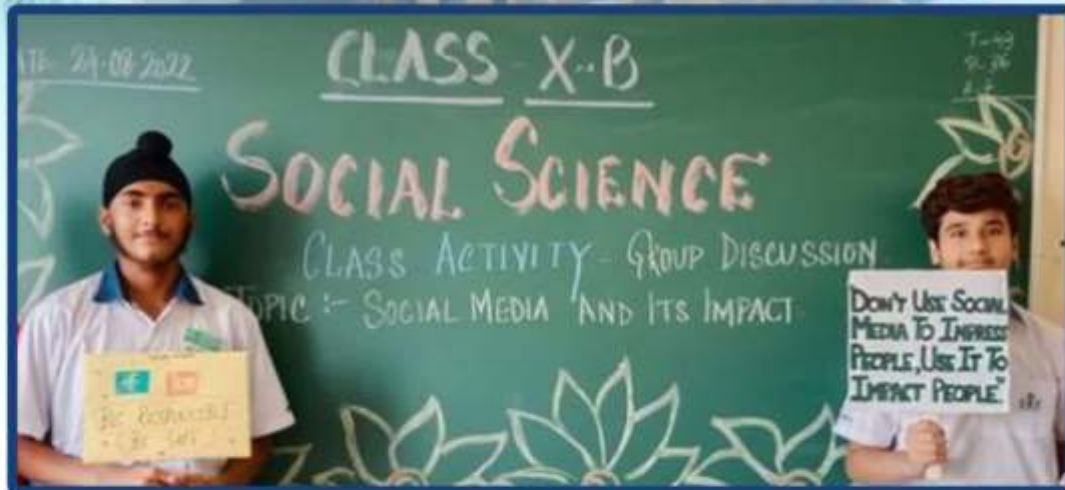

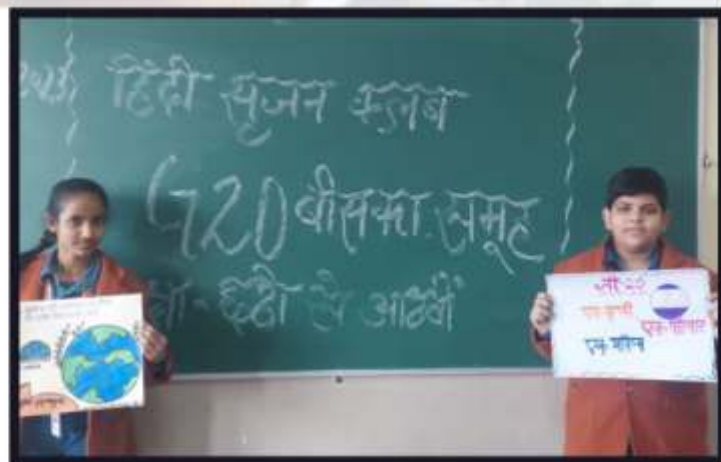




"Leprosy is something we need to fight together to make this world a healthier place to live."
