

Paper tearing and pasting activity is extremely fun for pre-schoolers and is also necessary for their finger muscles development. It helps them to enhance their grip on the paper and increases the hand strength as well as hand eye coordination.

A Tearing and Pasting Competition was organized in Aadharshila Vidyapeeth for class Pre-School on 28.10.2021. The children tore coloured papers into small pieces and stuck them in the outline of balloons. The work was to be done neatly and quickly. This helped to develop motor skills of the tiny tots. It was a structured activity in which children were made to paste the torn paper inside a balloon made on a chart paper. A great activity to keep pre-schoolers engaged and entertained.





DIWALI CARD MAKING COMPETITION

Diwali- 'The festival of Lights' is celebrated across India. The name 'Deepawali' literally means an 'array of lights'. To make the students understand the importance of Diwali, Aadharshila Vidyapeeth organised a 'Diwali Card Making Competition', on November 3, 2021.

In this competition, the teachers explained the importance of Diwali, a festival that spiritually signifies the victory of light over darkness, knowledge over ignorance, good over evil, and hope over despair. Children decorated diyas with colours and glitter. The bright splash of colours on paper symbolised the spirit of festivity and excitement that was just around the corner. The students participated enthusiastically in the competition as it gave them an opportunity to showcase their creativity.





ZEBRA CROSSING ACTIVITY

Apprising our vivid learners about the Traffic Rules and their importance, a 'Zebra Crossing Activity' was observed in Aadharshila Vidyapeeth for the students of Pre-School on 11.11. 2021. Aiming with this thought, Aadharshila Vidyapeeth conducted 'Let's Twist' (Dance Competition) on "BOLLYWOOD SONGS" for the students of Pre-School and Pre-Primary on 18.11.2021. It was a great way to build an emotional resilience in young Aadharshilians. It increased self-confidence and self-esteem in them. THUMB PRINTING

Printmaking allows children to try out lots of different techniques and to see cause and effects in action more dramatically than with simply painting or drawing. Prints with finger tips and thumb are fun for kids. It is a wonderful sensory experience for them. This messy play stimulates their creativity and imagination and helps them in strengthening finger and hand muscles. To develop all these skills in our little learners, Aadharshila Vidyapeeth conducted **'Thumb Printing (letter G)'** activity for the students of Pre-School on November 25,2021.

Children dipped their thumbs in green or purple colour and made beautiful prints on an A4 size sheet. They further drew twigs and leaves of grapes. The activity helped the body and brain to integrate information and it is also one of the most relaxing and creative ways to express feelings. Children explored this interesting way of printing and had lot of fun with colours.





FOREST FRIENDS

Children can understand the world by imitating it. Role Play is an art of acting. It is always a fun to see children get into a character and act out a role. Parents mixed all the letters and students pasted the small and capital letters on one sheet. The activity helped the children to engage and nurture their creativity and encouraged them to explore and develop their fine motor skills.

CAT CRAFT MAKING ACTIVITY

To build children's cognitive, physical and social skills and to sharpen the visualization and memorization of complex designs in mind, Aadharshila Vidyapeeth conducted Cat Craft Activity on Octoeber 28, 2021 for the students of Pre-Primary. Different sized and coloured bangles were used by the students to make the shape of a cat. It was fascinating to see how students combined their thoughts and feelings on a paper. FINGER PUPPET ACTIVITY

Puppetry is an ancient art first recorded in Greece. It encourages story telling through craftsmanship. Some students came up with the idea of a puppet theatre which was quite impressive. This project helped to develop visual and kinaesthetic abilities of the students through an ancient art form.






LITTLE NARRATOR COMPETITION






LET'S LOCATE ACTIVITY






INTRA ART COMPETITION




Disaster Management

Result awaited as we keep our fingers crossed.






GURU TEG BAHADUR – POEM & CREATIVE WRITING COMPETITION






VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK' 2021




VEER GATHA PROJECT


NUKKAD NATAK


