# MERA DESH, MERA ABHIMAN








# **SHOW YOUR MOVES**

# **LET'S SHAKE A LEG**






# PATTERN MAKING ACTIVITY

It was a great learning experience for all the students and they enjoyed doing the activity.






# POEM RECITATION ACTIVITY






# **INTRASCHOOL MUSIC COMPETITION**



"Imagination is more important than knowledge."




# **AADHARSHILA SHINNING STARS!**

### **E- PLEDGE AGAINST DRUGS**


"Awareness is a powerful catalyst for a positive change."








## **HUNAR 2021-2022**

# **VACCINATION CAMP - DOSE 1**

"If we want to return to normalization of teaching in schools, we should help the government bodies in successful execution of vaccination of students."


Aadharshila Vidyapeeth has always proactively pioneered in tough times to work in collaboration with the government's initiatives. The school has reached out to the district health department and sought an appointment for vaccination at the nearest Central Government Health Scheme empanelled hospital. Aadharshila Vidyapeeth has converted its campus into a dedicated Covid vaccination centre for the 15-18 age group to get vaccinated in a safe place on January 11,2022. A letter to parents informing about the vaccination process was sent. The students were registered and around 85 students received their first dose of Covid-19 Covaxon jab in the centre. The students were asked about their health status and sent to Observation Room for half an hour. Aadharshila Vidyapeeth reiterated its commitment to sharing its resources with the community for a safer and better tomorrow. Due to the spike in cases, many students didn't come to school. Some were also unsure about vaccination and would like to wait and watch before they decide to get their children vaccinated. At the centre, all the COVID protocols were observed.
