


Farewell Class - XII 2022-23



Several events were organised such as Its movie time, Tech Talk, Build your website, Logo Buzz and IT Quiz.


The students were given an opportunity to reveal their bright and creative ideas. An outstanding platform was provided to the students enabling their artistic presentation to come to the fore.

The idea was to acquaint the students with the life and the great work of M.K. Gandhi, popularly known as Mahatma Gandhi.







VEER BAL DIWAS




A mind sport, that attempts to answer questions posed correctly, in order to win, defines quiz that presents the most invaluable prize- the gift of knowledge.


