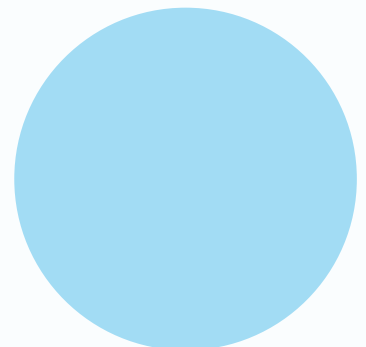
Dear Students, Parents, and Teachers,

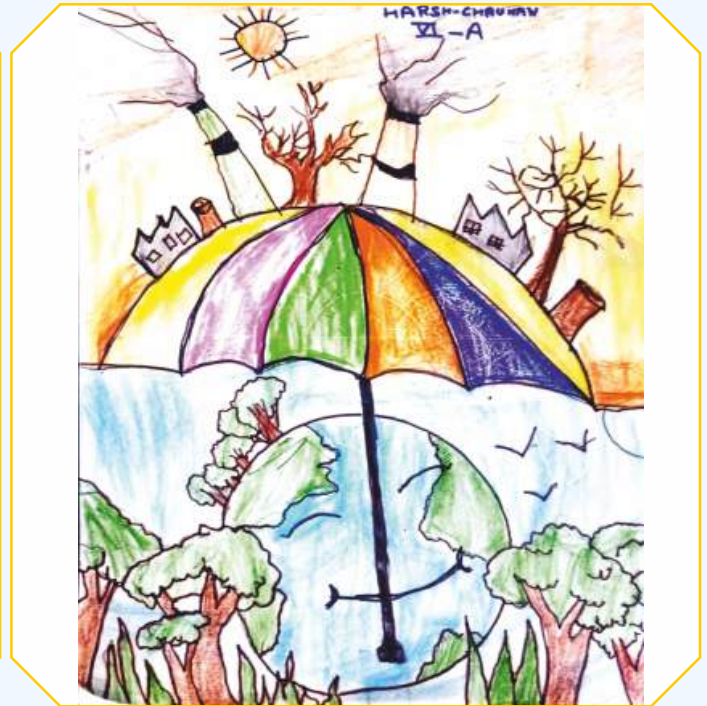
Eco Club Initiatives: Nurturing a Greener Tomorrow

3. Alliteration

“Break the chains, embrace what's true” (repetition of b sound).

4. Imagery

“Walk in nature, learn, explore” – creates a mental picture of living freely.

“Stealing youth from morning light” – visual image of lost joy and energy.

5. Symbolism

“Blue” – symbolizes the blue glow of screens, also the sadness they cause.

“Books stay closed” – symbolizes lost knowledge and creativity.

6. Contrast

Between darkness of addiction (chains, silence, weakness) and light of freedom (open skies, brighter life).

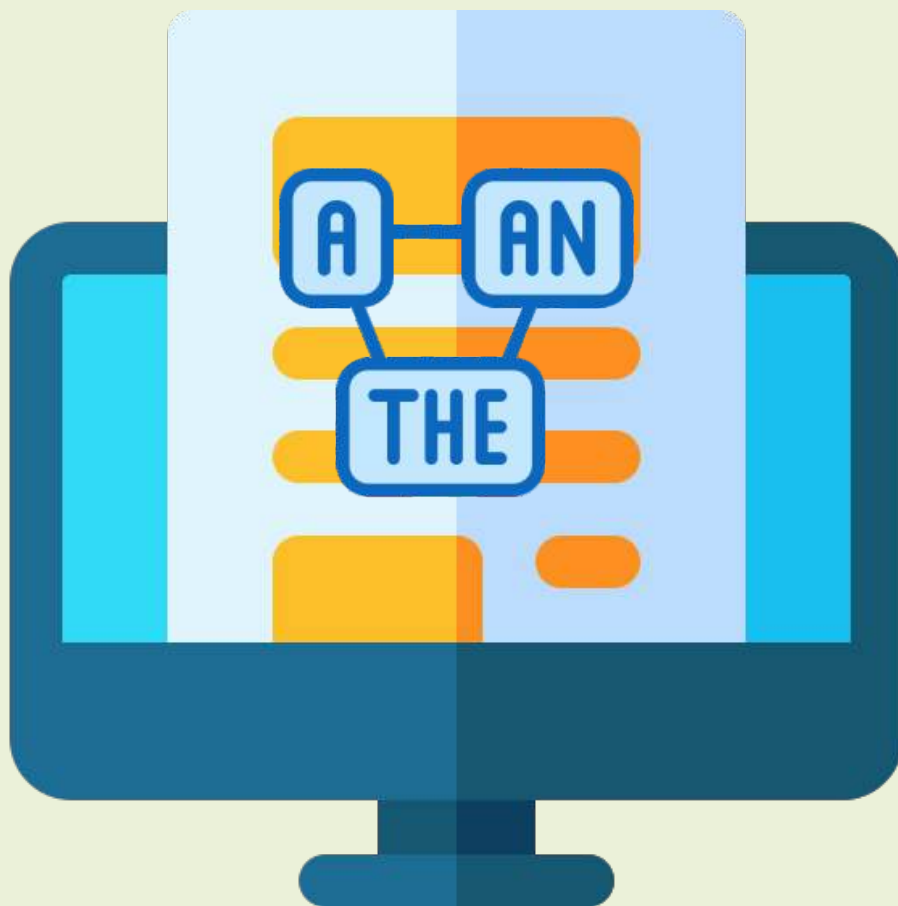

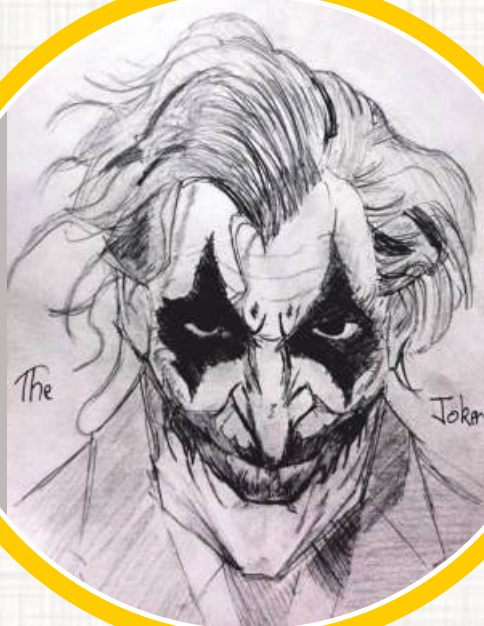

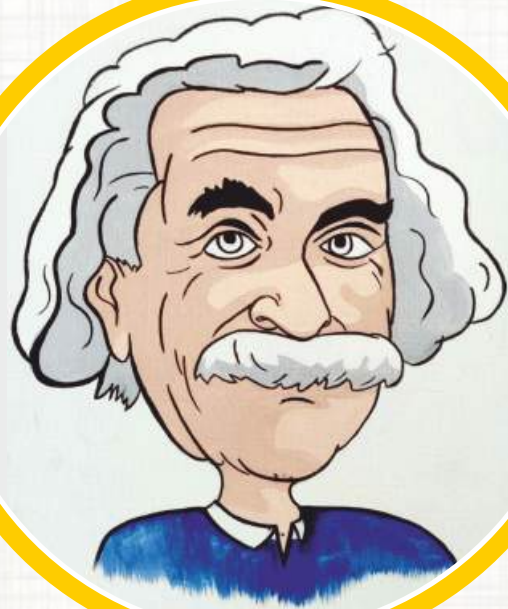
